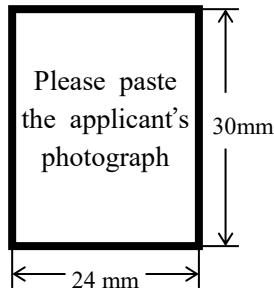

Code of Ethics for JIS Z 2305 Personnel

- Declaration of Proper Conduct -

The Certification Body of the Japan Non-Destructive Inspection (hereinafter referred to as the JSNDI) establishes the following code of ethics that individuals involved in non-destructive testing under the certification program (JIS Z 2305 "Qualifications and Certification of Non-Destructive Testing Personnel") implemented by the JSNDI should adhere to. Furthermore, "individuals involved in non-destructive testing" refer to employers, trainers, applicants, certificate holders, and others who are involved in the certification program in various capacities, as implemented by the JSNDI.

1.Mission: Individuals involved in non-destructive testing must strive to promote and enhance the sound dissemination of non-destructive testing technology based on their professional knowledge and experience. They should work towards supplying society with reliable non-destructive testing technology.

2.Compliance with the Law: Individuals involved in non-destructive testing must comply with legal regulations and also adhere to this code of ethics and compliance requirements.

3.Maintaining Integrity: Individuals involved in non-destructive testing, recognizing the significance of their mission, must strive to maintain integrity and work towards upholding a high level of societal trust.

4.Contribution to Society: Individuals involved in non-destructive testing should proactively share information with society about their professional achievements for the sound dissemination and enhancement of non-destructive testing technology. They must also assist in the development of future professionals. However, they must not violate any confidentiality obligations to organizations or entities they are bound by

5.Prohibition of Unethical Conduct: Individuals involved in non-destructive testing must conduct themselves with honesty and integrity, refraining from any form of misconduct that represents dishonesty in connection with the association's qualification examinations, certification activities, and certified qualifications. They should strive to maintain discipline in their actions and provide value to society as non-destructive testing professionals. This includes:

- (1) Providing false information during registration and application. (2) Fabricating information. (3) Allowing third parties who are not examination applicants to take certification exams. (4) Illegitimate use of certified qualifications. (5) Engaging in any behavior that deviates from societal morals.

6.Self-Improvement: Individuals involved in non-destructive testing should continuously engage in self-improvement, consistently striving to acquire the latest knowledge and skills for the sound dissemination and enhancement of non-destructive testing technology.

7.Handling of Ethical Violations: When it is suspected that individuals involved in non-destructive testing have violated this code of ethics or have significantly tarnished their reputation as non-destructive testing professionals, the JSNDI Certification Body will take appropriate actions.

8.Amendment of Regulations: These regulations can be modified by the resolution of the JSNDI Certification Body.

Upon certification, by JSNDI, to the JIS Z 2305 Standard I agree to abide by the above Code of Ethic as long as I maintain certification, and understand the certifications do not constitute any form of license nor any operating authorization.

I understand the rights of JSNDI to suspend or revoke any certificate granted if I abuse the privileges therein granted to me.
